For example, there may be a Care Team for Young Parents, people experiencing divorce, employment or financial struggles, or bereavement support.

HEALTH CABINET

The Health Cabinet is an informal gathering of the health care professionals in GCC. This will be a way for them to get to know each other, but also to give input about the ways we might care for the health questions and concerns of the congregation during this interim time.

VISITATION SCHEDULE
